TRANSITIONAL PERIOD FOR EXISTING PRIVATE HIRE VEHICLE DOOR SIGNAGE

SUMMARY

- 1.1 At the Taxi Licensing and Appeals Committee on 6 December 2012, committee resolved to introduce standardised door signage with or without advertisements.
- 1.2 The report presented on 30 August in relation to this stated that if approved, 'the additional changes willmean that some existing door signs currently in use will not comply with the new condition. It will therefore be necessary to allow a transitional period for the existing door signs to be replaced if an operator does not want to take advantage of the new advertising provision. More consideration of this can be given'.
- 1.3 No detailed resolution was ever determined by the committee in relation to the transitional period to be applied.

RECOMMENDATION

2.1 To agree a transitional period ending on 31 December 2013 by when the existing door signs must comply with revised door sign conditions if an operator does not want to take advantage of the new advertising provision.

REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION

3.1 To allow operators to plan into their service delivery the cost of replacement door signs.

SUPPORTING INFORMATION

4.1 At the Taxi Licensing and Appeals Committee on 6 December 2012, committee resolved to introduce standardised door signage with or without advertisements.

- 4.3 No detailed resolution was ever determined by the committee in relation to the transitional period to be applied.
- 4.5 In order to address this omission, to apply proportionality and allow clarity to the trade on when the existing door signs have to comply with the revised condition 11, it is proposed that a transitional period ending on 31 December 2013is agreed.
