It was reported that the government intended to commence both powers but had asked for views on the proposals before preparing regulations.

The Committee were informed that to assist them in the process officers had suggested their draft comments on the proposals within the report. Members thanked officers for their responses and agreed that they were all correct apart

from question 8 regarding club premises certificates and their exemption from the late night levy. It was agreed that if clubs were exempt from the late night levy, this could encourage premises to develop into clubs and that clubs can and do contribute to problems within the night time economy.

Resolved to authorise Mike Kay, Head of Environmental Health and Licensing to respond to the Home Office on behalf of the Committee with the consultation responses.
