- 7. carry out any other statutory duties and responsibilities allocated to local authority scrutiny committees.

 - Community Recovery
 - Partnership engagement including city centre and VCS
 - Community Safety and Integration Neighbourhoods
 - Environmental Protection Housing Standards, Licensing and Emergency Planning
 - Libraries
 - Tourism
 - Street Cleaning, Waste and Fleet Management
 - Highways Maintenance, Grounds Maintenance, Land drainage
 - Streetpride (including parks / city centre bins)
 - Parks & Open Spaces
 - Trading Standards, Bereavement Services & Food Safety and Building Consultancy
 - Leisure
 - Markets
