There are 21 measures for each MAT team to update within DORIS on a quarterly basis.


An email will be circulated on a quarterly basis to the relevant officer with a link to the update form and the deadline for submission to DORIS.

- 3. Make sure the period shown is the quarter for which you wish to enter data. If you want to change the period then just click on the dropdown arrow and choose the relevant period end date.




### Enter the following information:

- ✓ Period Actual data for the discrete quarter e.g. for Q2 it will include July, August, September figures.
- ✓ YTD (year to date) total for the year so far e.g. for Q2 it will include April through to September figures.
- ✓ Commentary context, additional information to the figures submitted.
- 4. Click the <u>submit</u> button (measures should turn green). This can be done whilst submitting data to save information entered into the measure form so far.
- 5. Close the form.
