1. Click on the link within the email to open the DORIS update measure form.
2. Enter your username (same as PC login) and password is password (all lowercase)
3. Make sure the period shown is the quarter for which you wish to enter data. If you want to change the period then just click on the dropdown arrow and choose the relevant period end date.

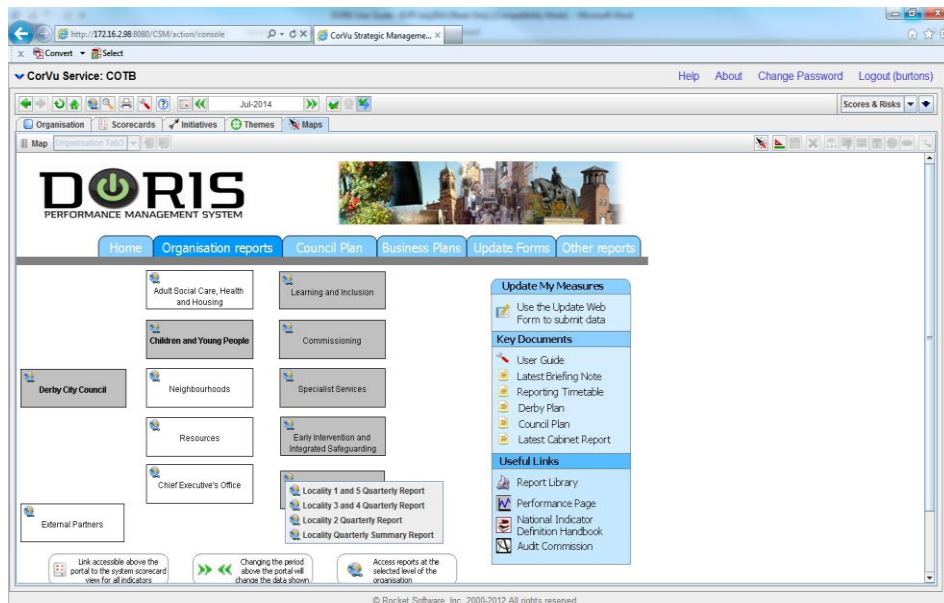


Enter the following information:

- ✓ Period Actual - data for the discrete quarter e.g. for Q2 it will include July, August, September figures.
  - ✓ YTD (year to date) – total for the year so far e.g. for Q2 it will include April through to September figures.
  - ✓ Commentary – context, additional information to the figures submitted.
4. Click the **submit** button (measures should turn green). This can be done whilst submitting data to save information entered into the measure form so far.
  5. Close the form.
