The Apprenticeship Programme Update

Purpose

- 1.1 To provide an update on the Apprenticeship Team's current priorities.

- 4.1.1 **Partnership working to promote our apprenticeships**

The Apprenticeship Team is actively working with internal and external partners to raise awareness of our apprenticeship opportunities and to promote inclusion in learning and employment.

This includes:

- Attended GCSE results day at Bemrose school on 25th August
- Attending Jobs Fair at Pride Park on 16th September
- Attending University of Derby Talent Fair on 13th October
- Participating in the corporate recruitment and retention group
- Continuing to attend internal Boards (Including the Education Employment & Training and Equality Diversity & Inclusion Boards)
- Continued networking with external groups and partners
- Working with the Communications and Marketing team to plan events for National Apprenticeship Week in February 2023.

4.1.2 Leadership and Management Programme

The next cohort for the Leadership and Management programme start in September; we have approximately 16 colleagues starting on levels 3 -7 with the University of Derby.

We have a very successful Mentoring network in place, every apprentice on these programmes has access to a dedicated Mentor to support them throughout their programme.

4.1.3 New Start Apprentices

The Apprenticeship Team have been working with managers across several services and our schools over the summer, and the Council is currently recruiting approximately 10 new start apprentices. These include Business Administration Level 3; Assistant Accounts Level 3; Customer Service Practitioner Level 2; Teaching Assistant Level 3; Early Years Practitioner Level 3 and Information Communications Technician Level 3. We are aiming to have them all started by the end of September.

4.1.4 Workforce Development

In addition to new start apprenticeships, the Apprenticeship Team are currently working with several colleagues to facilitate their development utilising apprenticeship programmes. These apprenticeships are across a range of roles and professions, and they include Internal Audit Professional Level 7; Accountancy Professional Level 7; Children, Young People and Families Practitioner Level 4; Children Young People and Families Manager Level 5; Teacher Level 6 and Facilities Manager Level 4.

4.2 **Personnel Committee's recommendation to increase the apprenticeship salary**

The Personnel Committee's recommendation has been put to the Strategic Director of Resources. The recommendation is currently being considered, and an update will be provided to the Personnel Committee once a decision has been made.

4.3 Levy Payments

As of 26 August 2022, the Council has transferred a total of £3,779,100.55 into the Education and Skills Funding Agency (ESFA) Apprenticeship Levy Digital Account since the start of the Levy in April 2017.

To date the Council has drawn down £2,426,454.11 for internal apprenticeship training programmes and transferred £69,908.69 of our Levy Fund to six outside organisations.

Between April 2022 and August 2022, £9,350.15 of the Council's Levy Fund has expired. In the last calendar year, the Council has only experienced the expiration of funds on three occasions amounting to £31,227.67.

The total amount of Levy drawn down between May 2017 to August 2022 is £2,506,795.

Other options

6.1 Do nothing. This is not considered to be a viable option, the main reason being the Council wants to maximise the Levy spend.

Financial and value for money issues

7.1 The Council continues to make contributions to the Levy monthly. Some of the funding is being used to pay for apprentice programmes every month. The Council has a rolling 24 months to use the funds and has experienced the expiration of funds.

Legal implications

8.1 We are continually working with Legal and Procurement Services to ensure we are meeting our legal obligations with the Levy and procurement rules. The Government have put legislation in place; 'The Public Sector Apprenticeship Targets Regulations 2017'. Public sector bodies in scope of the target must submit annual returns appropriately demonstrating that they have had regard to achieving the 2.3% target. The Government have not put any penalties in place for not meeting the target, the onus is on having regard for it.
