## Petition - Removal of bollards in Chatsworth Drive

## SUPPORTING INFORMATION

- 1.1 A petition was formally presented to the Area Panel meeting on 29 November 2006 signed by 26 residents of Chatsworth Drive requesting the removal of 8 bollards located on road build out areas on the new section of Chatsworth Drive.
- 1.2 Following receipt of the petition in December 2006, officers carried out initial on-site investigations. These investigations revealed that the site is substantially completed and whilst the bollards have been erected to the Councils requirements the need for all 16 has been reviewed in light of the request from the petitioners. Officers have assessed the situation and are content from a safety point of view that the number of bollards can be reduced. The developer has been approached and he has agreed to remove 8 of the bollards.

## PROPOSED ACTION

2.1 To note that the developer will remove 8 number bollards before the highways are adopted and maintained at public expense.
