

Establishment of the Corporate Parenting Sub-Board

SUMMARY

- 1.1 Under Overview and Scrutiny Procedure Rule OS2 of the Constitution, the Board can establish a sub commission, without approval from the Full Council.
- 1.2 At its meeting on 13 September 2012 the Children and Young People Commission agreed to establish a Corporate Parenting Sub Commission
- 1.3 This Paper asks the Board to determine whether it wishes to establish a Corporate Parenting Sub-Board for 2012-13.
- 1.4 If the Board wishes to establish a Sub-Board it is requested that the Membership is agreed.

RECOMMENDATION

- 2.1 To agree to establish a Corporate Parenting Sub-Board with the same terms of reference as in 2012-13.
- 2.2 To agree Membership of the Sub-board.
- 2.3 To agree that the Chair and Vice-Chair of the Sub-Board be appointed at the first meeting of the Sub-Board.
- 2.4 To consider whether anyone should be invited to be a co-optee on the Corporate Parenting Sub-Board

- 3.2 To ensure the Sub- Commission has a clearly defined Terms of Reference which clearly defines its role.
