Standing Advisory Council for Religious Education – SACRE – New Representatives

RECOMMENDATION

1.1 To approve the appointment of Kate Tippen as the Roman Catholic representative for a four year term.

SUPPORTING INFORMATION

- 2.1 SACRE overseas Religious Education RE and Collective Worship. It is required by law that RE be taught in schools but RE is not part of the National Curriculum so RE is a local responsibility.
- 2.2 SACRE is designed to represent all the interests of the local community including elected members, representatives of faith communities and members of the education community.
- 2.3 The main function of SACRE is to advise the LEA on matters related to Collective Worship in community schools and some other schools and on the Religious Education given in accordance with their Agreed Syllabus. SACRE publishes a report annually of its work.
- 2.4 SACRE does not currently have a Roman Catholic representative. Kate Tippen has been nominated as the Roman Catholic representative on the Derby SACRE. She is the Primary RE adviser for the Diocesan Education Service at the Diocesan Centre, Mackworth.
