SUMMARY

- DER/11/16/01362 : 35-36 St Marys Gate, Derby – internal alterations to include installation of six 'pod' en-suite bathrooms and sanitary accommodation to basement
 - DER/03/17/00352 : former Post Office Building, Victoria Street, Derby – display of a non-illuminated fascia sign and window vinyls
 - DER/02/17/00245: First floor, 1-5 Iron Gate, Derby – retention of change of use of first floor to escape room (use class D2)

 - DER/03/17/00271: Darley Playing Fields, Old Chester Road, Derby – tennis courts, artificial sports pitch, informal sports area with sports wall, outdoor gym equipment and access path
 - DER/10/16/01285: garages adjacent to Lilac Court, Lilac Close, Alvaston, Derby
 - DER/02/17/00162: 27 Arthur Street, Derby – installation of replacement windows to the front elevation
 - DER/03/17/00288: 5 Victor Avenue, Derby – single storey front extension to dwelling house (entrance lobby) and installation of render
 - DER/03/17/00314: 17-24 Victoria Street, Derby – erection of fencing and hoarding to secure the site
