Chapel Street - Spondon

A working group of council officers from public transport, school travel plan, road safety, traffic management and road maintenance teams has been set up. It has agreed the need for more data before any detailed proposals could be developed. Therefore, in early June, in the area around Chapel Street there will be:

- Parking Surveys
- Turning Counts
- Pedestrian Count

Once the data is collected it is proposed that more discussion will take place between officers and councillors to allow some potential options to be drawn up. It is anticipated that public consultation on these options will take place in the autumn.

Spondon Neighbourhood Forum

The first Spondon Neighbourhood Forum public meeting was held on 11 July 2007. 60 people attended including the Spondon Councillors, residents, local service providers and some local business organisations. It was chaired by Councillor Williams and the meeting:

- Received information about how the Forum will work.
- Residents identified their priorities for Spondon using electronic voting handsets
- The Forum agreed to form a Board and identified 16 people who wanted to be on the Spondon Neighbourhood Board

The first Spondon Neighbourhood Board meeting took place on 8 August 2007. Chaired by Councillor Williams. 25 People attended including Councillors, 13 residents and nine officers. The meeting discussed the terms of reference for the Forum and Board, received feedback from the Forum meeting and identified a number of priorities to be tackled in the next financial year including such things as Anti Social Behaviour, traffic congestion and the lack of youth facilities. As well as looking at issues they also came up with a number of solutions. A series of options to tackle the main priorities will be fed back to the next meeting of Spondon Neighbourhood Forum on Thursday 4 October at Spondon cricket club. Everyone is invited. The meeting starts at 6.30pm.

The Council approved a new framework for neighbourhood working at its meeting on 18 July 2007. Subject to Council's agreement of the final proposals on 12 September 2007, the final round of Area Panel meetings will be in September/early October. Consultation on the 2008/09 Highways and Transport Work programme

During 2006 and early 2007 consultation was undertaken with Area Panels as part of the process of developing the highways and transport work programme for 2007/08. The schemes included in the work programme are largely funded from capital budgets allocated through the Local Transport Plan, LTP, process.

Following the consultation, at the March/April 2007 round of Area Panels we provided details of the schemes included in the 2007/08 highways and transport work programme in each Ward. The full programme was approved by Council Cabinet on 20 February 2007.

Following a Council review of the current arrangements for area and neighbourhood working, it is proposed that a new framework will be introduced which transforms Area Panels into Neighbourhood Forums in each of the Council's 17 Wards.

The move to the new neighbourhood framework means that this year we will be seeking the views of Ward Councillors and residents through the Neighbourhood Forums and Neighbourhood Boards on the issues they feel need to be focused on and transport schemes or initiatives we could consider implementing to try and address them.

The consultation with Neighbourhood Forums and Neighbourhood Boards will form part of the way in which we develop the detailed highways and transport work programme for the 2008/09 financial year. We will also consult with other groups and organisations across the city.

A final programme will be presented to Council Cabinet for approval in February 2008.

A report will be presented to Neighbourhood Boards in March/April 2008 outlining the elements of the Council Cabinet approved Highways and Transport Work Programme 2008/09 within their Ward. For more information contact Michelle Spamer, Area Coordination Officer, 01332 715064
