

Children and Young People Attainment Results

SUMMARY

- 1.1 The CYP Commission requested further information on the latest Standard Assessments Tests (SATs) results. A Performance Surgery is scheduled to take place on 13 September 2011 which will focus on Early Years and Key Stage 1 / 2 attainment results. This report includes results for these levels, as well as an action plan for improvement, which may be of interest to CYP Commission members as they review the wider SAT results.

RECOMMENDATION

- 2.1 To note the background information (including action plan) to be considered at Performance Surgery on 13 September 2011.

REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION

- 3.1 To reduce duplication of reporting, it was agreed to circulate the Performance Surgery papers to CYP Commission members to inform their review of SAT results.

SUPPORTING INFORMATION

- 4.1 A Performance Surgery will take place at 11-1pm on 13 September 2011. This will focus specifically on Early Years and Key Stage 1 / 2 Attainment – National Indicators 72, 73, 92, 93, 94.

The Chair and Vice Chair of CYP Commission are invited to attend this session along with Opposition Lead members if relevant. The Strategic Director and Accountable Officers are also in attendance, with other stakeholders (such as head teachers).

This has been issued to CYP Commission members to inform the presentation that will be given by representatives from the Learning and Inclusion Department at the Scrutiny Commission meeting on 13 September.
