Report of the Director of Planning and Transportation

The City of Derby Local List of Buildings of Historic or Architectural Importance

SUMMARY

- 1.1 After commencing the review of the City's Local List of buildings of architectural or historic importance in January 2007, a lengthy process has been undertaken to identify buildings/structures for inclusion in the revised list of Buildings of Local Historic/Architectural Importance.
- 1.2 A Local List Panel, chaired by Maxwell Craven and represented for CAAC by Peter Billson, was convened.
- 1.3 Nominations for new entries were received from members of the public and amenity groups, and the Local List Panel reviewed both these and the entries on the existing list to put forward recommendations to the Cabinet Members for Planning and Transportation and Leisure and Culture for approval.
- 1.4 The revised list was finally reviewed by the Cabinet Members on 1 April 2010 and recommended to Cabinet for approval.
- 1.5 The revised list, attached as Appendix 2, was approved by Council Cabinet on 27 July 2010.

RECOMMENDATION

2.1 To receive report and note the final list of buildings and structures as set out in Appendix 2 to be published as the revised City of Derby Local List.

SUPPORTING INFORMATION

3.1 Compiling local lists is recommended by the national Government, and guidance for local authorities is proposed as part of the Heritage Protection Review. The recently published Planning Policy Statement 5 for the Historic Environment specifically allows local authorities to consider non-designated assets, such as locally listed buildings, as a material consideration when making decisions on planning applications.

- 3.2 The final list of properties recommended by the Local List Panel for inclusion, and subsequently approved by the Members and Council Cabinet, is attached as Appendix 1. The prefix of the reference number for the properties that have been taken forward from the existing list is 'LLE', and the prefix of the reference number for the properties and street furniture that have been newly nominated for inclusion is 'LL'. The prefix of the reference number for street furniture from the existing list is LLSF.
- 3.3 The revised list will be organised by ward and published on the Council's updated Local List web page, and a small number of paper copies will be made available.
