Report of the Neighbourhoods Commission

Derby and Derbyshire Year of Culture

SUMMARY

1. The Neighbourhoods Commission had earlier decided to consider the Key Decision 'City of Culture'. This was later taken at Council Cabinet on 23 November under the title 'Derby and Derbyshire Year of Culture'. Claire Davenport then attended the Commission meeting on 9 December and spoke to the report considered by Cabinet. The Commission agreed to express its unanimous view on the proposals.

RECOMMENDATION

21. That Council Cabinet note the Neighbourhoods Commission unanimously support the decision to have a Derby and Derbyshire Year of Culture

REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION

3.1 The Commission supported the proposal in itself and, given the potential return in terms of positive coverage for Derby, regard the £42,000 as a very effective use of public money.
