

Report of the Strategic Director of Resources

Community Podiatry Services

SUMMARY

- 1.1 The Derbyshire Community Health Services NHS Trust is proposing to transfer its community podiatry services from Park Lane Surgery, Allestree, to either the Revive Clinic, based at Roe Farm, or to the Village Community Medical Centre based in Browning Street, or to Belper Clinic, based at Babington Hospital.
- 1.2 There are a number of advantages linked to this proposal:
 - The Revive clinic, the Village Community Medical Centre and Belper Clinic offer up to date purpose built clinical facilities.
 - Larger purpose built podiatry / chiropody suites.
 - Offers greater opening times for patients.
 - Disabled access, close to the car park.
- 1.3 The Trust has written to the patients using the service at Park Lane Surgery, explaining its proposals and is also seeking their views through questionnaire. The Trust also wishes to gauge the views of this Board.
- 1.4 The Public and Patient Involvement Officer will be attending the Board meeting to provide further details about their proposals and answer member queries.
