### NOTICE OF INTENTION TO PASS A RESOLUTION ON STREET TRADING AND THE DESIGNATION OF CONSENT STREETS

Notice is hereby given that Derby City Council intend to pass a resolution under Para 2, Schedule 4 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982.

The terms of the draft resolution are as follows:

That with effect from 1st April 2023, all existing designations of streets made pursuant to Schedule 4 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982 shall be revoked.

That with effect from 1 April 2023, all streets within the administrative boundary of Derby whether existing at the date of the coming into force of this resolution or in the future shall be designated as 'Consent Streets' for street trading purposes in accordance with Schedule 4 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982.

The effect of this resolution is to permit street trading on those streets only with the consent of Derby City Council.

Anyone wishing to make a representation on the proposed resolution should do so in writing to the Team Leader for Licensing, Derby City Council, The Council House, Corporation Street, Derby, DE1 2FS or via email at [licensing@derby.gov.uk](mailto:licensing@derby.gov.uk) quoting reference (AMR/Street Trading) within 28 days of the publication of this notice.

Any representations received within the time scale provided shall be considered by the Council and, if they think fit, the Council shall pass such a resolution.

Should no representations be received, this draft resolution shall be deemed as passed and shall come into effect on the 1 April 2023.
