Report on Ballater Close car parking issues

Background

A petition was received at Area Panel 2 on June 14th 2006 regarding parking issues at Ballater Close, Sinfin. The issue has been investigated by the Local Manager for Derby Homes and a report is provided below.

Information on Ballater Close

Total no of properties: 48 Derby Homes tenants: 35 Owner occupiers: 13

Current no of parking spaces: 40

Ballater close has one large car park at the rear of the properties for 18 car spaces which resident's state is underused due to vandalism. There are two parking inlets, one at the top end with 7 spaces and one at the bottom end with 6 spaces. There is also a turning circle at the bottom end which people park in with room for 5 cars. See map 1.

Petition request

Due to ongoing vandalism and disputes the following have been requested by residents.

- 1. Dropped kerb and additional parking spaces in front of 56 to 68 Ballater Close. (see picture no. 2)
- 2. Felling of a tree adjacent to car parking inlet next to no 7.
- 3. Create an extra parking inlet next to 56 Ballater. (see picture no. 3)
- 4. CCTV cameras on the rear car park behind no 50 to 54 Ballater Close.

Derby Homes findings

- 1. Additional spaces in front of 56 to 68.
 - Request sent to Jon Oakes Arboriculture Officer to see if tree could be felled in front of 56 to 68. He responded saying that this tree is a superb specimen and would not be felled.
 - Met with a surveyor on 08.06.06. He advised that making the grassed area into a car park would only make room for 2 car parking spaces. In the surveyors opinion he didn't think we would get permission to fell the tree. Work would need to include moving 1 lamp post. The cost to undertake this work would cost £7591.00
- 2. Felling tree near to no 7.

- Request sent to Jon Oakes Arboriculture Officer to see if tree could be felled. He responded saying that this tree would be felled. This work has since been completed.
- 3. Create extra parking inlet next to no 56
 - Met with a surveyor on 08.6.06. He advised that this would create and additional 3 parking spaces at approximately £8,217.
- 4. CCTV cameras on rear car park
 - Quote required.
- 5. A letter has been sent to all residents on Ballater Close advising that Derby Homes is investigating the parking situation. (See attached copy number 4 and 5)
- 6. Contacted local police requesting the amount of reported incidents of vandalism to cars in the rear car park.
- 7. Contacted the Community Safety Partnership regards vandalism to cars.

Summary information

- 1. It is not feasible to put parking spaces in front of 56 to 68 Ballater Close. The tree in front of these properties will not be felled.
- 2. Additional parking next to 56 Ballater Close is feasible and will be investigated.
- 3. The possibility of a mobile CCTV camera in rear car park will be investigated.
- 4. The tree has been felled near No 7 Ballater Close.


