Adults and Health Scrutiny Review Board Topic Review

Purpose

- 1.1 Members of the Corporate Services Scrutiny Review Board agreed at the meeting held on 5 July 2022 to carry out a topic review into obesity in Derby.
- 1.2 During informal discussions, consideration was given to the scope of the topic review and the following possible lines of enquiry were identified
 - How the Board could ensure that the Council is working to ensure that residents of Derby avoid becoming obese.
 - Whether the Council has been successful in supporting obese residents to lose weight and live healthier lifestyles.
 - The focus of the topic review should be 'what has the Council done to ensure that residents of Derby are supported in preventing obesity and reversing obesity.'
