Outturn Report: Area Panel 2 Budget 2004/5

SUPPORTING INFORMATION

- 1.1 In 2004/5, Area Panel 2 was allocated a budget of £29,000. The Panel also had an additional budget of £6,441 carried forward from 2003/4, which means that a total budget of £35,441 was available for allocation to projects during 2004/5. The panel allocated £24,132 giving a carry forward budget of £11,309 to allocate to projects in 2005/6.
