Public Protection Service Amended Fees and Charges 2021 / 22

Purpose

- 1.1 The 2021/22 fees and charges for the services are set out in Appendix 1. They were agreed and approved on the 31st March 2021, however the government decided to raise the statutory fees only for explosives (Fireworks) in late April 2021, a few weeks after the resolutions in March were made.
