

Health Protection Board Update

SUMMARY

- 1.1 The Derbyshire Health Protection Board met on 30 September 2013. This paper provides the Health and Wellbeing Board with an overview of the key issues discussed.
- 1.2 **Public Health England Area Team Seasonal Flu Vaccination Plan for 2013-2014**
The Derbyshire Health Protection Board discussed the Public Health England Area Team Seasonal Flu Vaccination Plan for 2013-2014 and the role of Occupational Health and the Local Authorities in supporting increases in uptake in key frontline health and social care staff.
- 1.3 **Measles**
Catch-Up Programme currently being implemented through primary care and the next phase of the programme would involve the Area Team in the planning of additional activities.
- 1.4 **Human Papilloma Virus (HPV)**
Uptake for all three doses in Derby City had exceeded the 90% target and Derbyshire County would be below the target. The primary care model of HPV delivery in Derbyshire County was being reviewed.
- 1.5 **The Abdominal Aortic Aneurysm (AAA) Screening Programme**
The Abdominal Aortic Aneurysm (AAA) Screening Programme had been successfully implemented and uptake from eligible men was very good. Bowel scope screening as part of the Bowel Cancer Screening Programme would be implemented in 2015 in Royal Derby Hospital and Chesterfield Royal Hospital.
- 1.6 **Immunisation programmes**
The Derbyshire Health Protection Board noted that four new immunisation programmes had been successfully introduced in 2013. A review was to be undertaken of the future delivery of the teenage Meningitis C, teenage Td/IPV and HPV vaccines to the adolescent population.
- 1.7 **Childhood immunisation**
There had been an increase in the uptake of the childhood immunisation programme in Derby City following the drop in 2012-2013 Quarter 4.
