Following your request for consultation on the cumulative licensing issues in Derby, I would venture there are none, other than a lack of premises to help continue a healthy night time economy. Surely this consultation should be abolished due to the many closures and the need for more licensed retail premises not less. In these straitened times the Police and the council need to save money not spend it unnecessarily.

The money saved could be used to attract operators and reduce anomalies such as private social clubs such as Spondon Snooker Club being taxed for rates as a night club on square footage (obviously 17 snooker tables and 6 pool tables take up a lot of space) rather than as a pub on turnover. This was a very significant reason for our closure after 25 years providing a community facility at no cost to the council. With the revaluation coming we felt very much a Milch cow with little or no support. Our demise is a loss to the overall tax take, so please think carefully about imposing yet more costs on the remaining operators please.
