Littleover District Centre: Review of proposals for on-street parking charges

SUMMARY

- 1.1 The new Cabinet Member for Planning and Transportation wishes to review the recommendation that was approved on 12 March 2008, with regard to parking proposals at Littleover District Centre.
- 1.2 A range of proposals were considered across the City on 12 March 2008 and a copy of the full report is included at Appendix 2.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- 2.1 To approve the proposed actions set out in Appendix 4 of the report of 12 March 2008; specifically in relation to Littleover District Centre. These are:
 - Not to confirm the proposals for the current order
 - To introduce the proposals by way of an experimental order, which will be in place for a minimum of 6 months and a maximum of 18 months
 - To include within the experiment, an additional tariff to cover a parking stay of 2 to 3 hours, with a charge of £1.00.
- 2.2 If recommendation 2.1 is not accepted, then Members will have to consider how a shortfall in income should be met.
