

RE: Indian Community Centre, Rawdon Street.

With reference to the above application, please take this letter as formal notification that it is the intention of the police to make representation against this application on the grounds that in its current form it undermines the licensing objectives indicated below;

1. The prevention of crime and disorder X
2. Public safety
3. The prevention of public nuisance X
4. The protection of children from harm X

Further explanation is given below.

A temporary event notice was received on 21st of October 2021 in relation to the premises known as The Indian Community Centre, Rawdon Street, Derby, DE23 6QR.

The TEN requests regulated entertainment from 2300 hours on Friday 5th of November 2021 to 0300 hours on Saturday 6th November 2021. The applicant is Baldev Singh Punni who is the current Designated Premises supervisor of the existing Premises Licence (PL10550382).

The notice describes the event as a 'baby christening celebration' and although the TEN notice does not request the sale of alcohol the applicant has included information in the notice that alcohol will be available stating it will be "own supply by party organisers"

A Temporary Event Notice has previously been requested at the premises on 17th October 2021 which resulted in a noise complaint being reported to the police.

'D' Divisional Headquarters Prime Parkway Chester Green DERBY DE1 3AB



Prior to this a TEN was requested on 12/09/2021 which resulted in Police having to attend the premises. A fight was reported between 10 people at the venue leading to two people being arrested. There was also large quantities of alcohol at the premises, namely bottles of spirits on the tables. The incident was reported at 0528 hours with the TEN being requested until 0300 hours.

Police Licensing Officers have had two separate meetings with the Indian Community Centre since the 12/09/21 to discuss these incidents. It appears to be case that when the events are taking place under TEN's the Designated Premises Supervisor and representatives from the Indian Community Centre of little or no control over the events.

The premises already hold a licence and I have considered the transfer of any relevant conditions however there are no conditions on the current licence that would give the police any assurance that the licensing objectives will be promoted.

The premises are aware of the concerns that the police have about such late events that are not being adequately controlled and a previous late TEN requested on 01/10/21 was objected to by Police.

We are still awaiting a response from the committee after a meeting with police on 8/10/21 yet a further TEN Has been submitted prior to this being resolved.

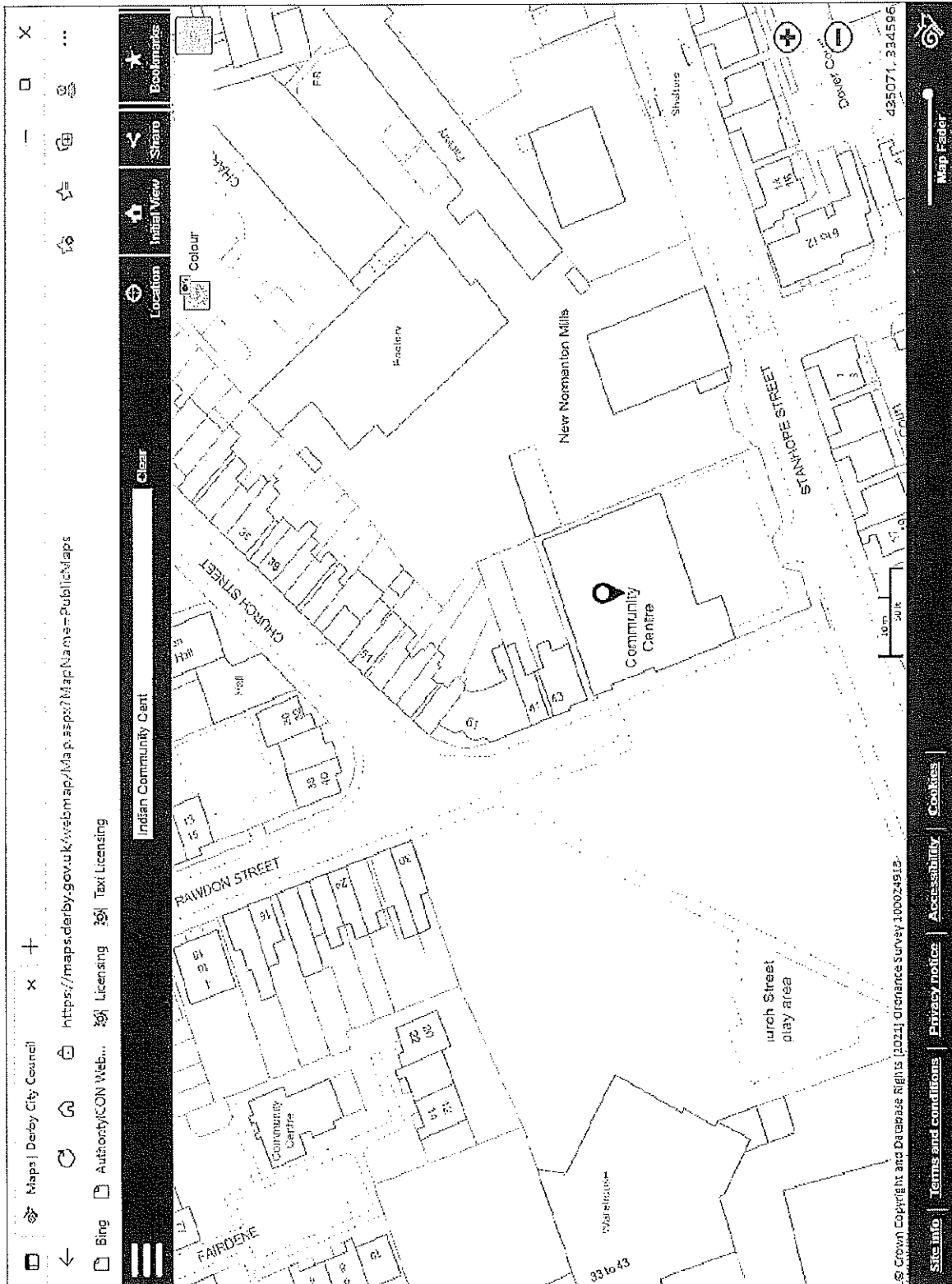
It is the view of the Chief Officer of Police that is this TEN is authorised the licensing objectives will be undermined.

ANNEX 1 – MANDATORY CONDITIONS

MANDATORY CONDITIONS - SUPPLY OF ALCOHOL

1. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence –
 - a. at any time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence; or
 - b. at any time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
2. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

MANDATORY CONDITIONS – DOOR SUPERVISION

3. Each individual required to be at the premises to carry out a security activity must be licensed by the Security Industries Authority.

MANDATORY CONDITION IMPLEMENTED ON 28 MAY 2014.

1. A relevant person shall ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied for consumption on or off the premises for a price which is less than the permitted price.
2. For the purposes of the condition set out in paragraph 1 —
 - (a) “duty” is to be construed in accordance with the Alcoholic Liquor Duties Act 1979;
 - (b) “permitted price” is the price found by applying the formula — $P = D + (D \times V)$
Where — P is the permitted price,
(ii) D is the rate of duty chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the duty were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol, and
(iii) V is the rate of value added tax chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the value added tax were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol;



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(c) "relevant person" means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a premises licence—

- (i) the holder of the premises licence,
- (ii) the designated premises supervisor (if any) in respect of such a licence, or
- (iii) the personal licence holder who makes or authorises a supply of alcohol under such a licence;

(d) "relevant person" means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a club premises certificate, any member or officer of the club present on the premises in a capacity which enables the member or officer to prevent the supply in question; and

(e) "valued added tax" means value added tax charged in accordance with the Value Added Tax Act 1994

3. Where the permitted price given by Paragraph (b) of paragraph 2 would (apart from this paragraph) not be a whole number of pennies, the price given by that sub-paragraph shall be taken to be the price actually given by that sub-paragraph rounded up to the nearest penny.

4. (1) Sub-paragraph (2) applies where the permitted price given by Paragraph (b) of paragraph 2 on a day ("the first day") would be different from the permitted price on the next day ("the second day") as a result of a change to the rate of duty or value added tax.

(2) The permitted price which would apply on the first day applies to sales or supplies of alcohol which take place before the expiry of the period of 14 days beginning on the second day.

MANDATORY CONDITIONS IMPLEMENTED 1 OCTOBER 2014

1. (1). The responsible person must ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises."

(2) An irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises –

(a) games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require or encourage, individuals to –

(i) drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol), or



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- (ii) drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);
 - (b) provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic in a manner which carries a significant risk of undermining a licensing objective.
 - (c) provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less in a manner which carries a significant risk of undermining a licensing objective.;
 - (d) selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner).
 - (e) dispensing alcohol directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of a disability).
2. The responsible person must ensure that free potable water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.
3. (1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder must ensure that an age verification policy is adopted in respect of the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.
- (2) The Designated Premises Supervisor in relation to the premises licence must ensure that the supply of alcohol at the premises is carried on in accordance with the age verification policy
- (3) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and either
- (a) holographic mark or
 - (b) an ultraviolet feature
4. The responsible person must ensure that –
- (a) where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures –
 - (i) beer or cider: ½ pint;
 - (ii) gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25 ml or 35 ml; and
 - (iii) still wine in a glass: 125 ml; and
 - (b) these measures are displayed in a menu, price list or other printed material which is available to customers on the premises: and
 - (c) where a customer does not in relation to a sale of alcohol specify the quantity of alcohol to be sold, the customer is made aware that these measures are available.
