Whilst not all Councillors will choose to stand in these elections, it is anticipated that the vast majority will be candidates; Officers will therefore need to be particularly careful to ensure compliance with the preelection period rules on publicity and use of Council resources.

Officers must take particular care when considering Reports to be taken to meetings scheduled for this time. Whilst the Council can continue determining planning applications and holding constitutional meetings, Officers should try to avoid taking reports on controversial issues and should consider carefully whether reports can be brought to meetings prior to 20 March or deferred until the new municipal year.
