Appointment of Representatives to the Standing Advisory **Council for Religious Education**

SUMMARY

- 1.1 The Standing Advisory Council for Religious Education (SACRE) oversees religious education (RE) and collective worship. It is required by law that RE be taught in schools. However, RE is not part of the National Curriculum so it is a local responsibility.
- 1.2 SACRE is designed to represent all the interests of the local community, including elected members, representatives of faith communities and members of the education community. Representatives are appointed for a four-year term, after which their membership requires renewal by Council.
