17/23 Appointment of the Chairs of Groups A and B

18/23 Windrush Presentation

George Grignon provided SCARE members with a presentation on how the Windrush generation and members of the Afro-Caribbean community had settled in Derby. This presentation covered stigma and challenges faced by those who had come to Derby to help Britain to recover following the second world war. The SACRE noted the important role that Thomas Dowse had played in helping members of the Afro-Caribbean community to find housing when they arrived in Derby.

The SACRE noted the contributions of other members of the Windrush generation including Charles Sheridan Hill who had set up the Derby West Indian Association and was also the fist black magistrate in Derby.

Members of SCARE asked whether this presentation had been taken into schools in Derby. It was noted that George Grignon aimed to present this in Derby's schools and was working with Embark. The Director of Learning Inclusion and Skills informed the SCARE that they would investigate how this presentation could be given in schools in Derby. The Baptist Church representative also agreed to raise this with the Derby Teaching Schools Alliance.

The representatives of Group D informed SACRE that they would discuss with the Cabinet Member for Children's Social Care, Learning and Skills whether a letter should be sent to government promoting a more diverse history curriculum in schools.

SACRE resolved:

- 1. to thank George Grignon and to endorse this presentation.
- 2. To recommend that this presentation was given at all schools in Derby.

19/23 SACRE Self Evaluation and NASACRE discussion

The Director of Learning Inclusion and Skills informed the SACRE that an exhibition on Derby's history would be taking place at the Museum of Making from April-May 2024. It was noted that an item on this may be brought to a future SCARE meeting. The Director of Learning Inclusion and Skills informed SCARE that the Museum of Making had recovered from flooding and that it was possible that this building could host the next SACRE meeting. The Clerk agreed to look into this.

It was noted that Derby SACRE was in the process of signing up to NASACRE. It was agreed that the SACRE Working Group would explore NASACRE's resources in time for SCARE's next meeting.

Resolved that the Clerk would explore whether the next meeting could take place at the Museum of Making.

20/23 Agreed Syllabus and schools questionnaire

It was agreed that a questionnaire would be sent to schools on the agreed syllabus. This would include what they thought were the pros and cons of the current agreed syllabus and what they'd like to see on the next one.
