# **Key Decisions**

# 215/04 Supplementary Planning Guidance on the After-Use of Sand and Gravel Sites

The Council Cabinet considered a report from the Director of Development and Cultural Services regarding the supplementary planning guidance on the after-use of sand and gravel sites. The Derby and Derbyshire Minerals Local Plan was jointly adopted by the Derby City and Derbyshire County Councils in April 2000. The Plan identified sufficient land to enable the area to make its appropriate contribution to the likely demand for sand and gravel over the plan period. The Plan indicated that the Council would provide guidance on what to do with sites once the sand and gravel had been worked out.

### **Options Considered**

No other options were considered.

### Decision

- To approve the adoption of the Supplementary Planning Guidance – SPG - on the after-use of Sand and Gravel Sites in the Trent Valley, subject to the views of the Planning and Environment Overview and Scrutiny Commission.
- 2. If the Overview and Scrutiny Commission expressed any adverse views, to reconsider these recommendations in light of their views at the next suitable Council Cabinet meeting.
