b) Agree 2014/15 Streetpride Spend Plan

The Board agreed the draft Streetpride spend plan for 2014/15 based on a budget of £22,934. Where an agreed item is to repeat work completed in 2013/14 costs have been based on actual costs for 2013/14. It is possible some of these prices will be different. The Board agreed an indicative amount of £8,000 towards slurry sealing footways which is sufficient to fund Sefton Road at £2,800 but not all of Cromford Road at £10,000. Therefore the Board will need to identify the worst part of Cromford Road or identify another footway
