

Director of Public Health Annual Report 2014

SUMMARY

- 1.1 The Director of Public Health (DPH) is required (under the Health and Social Care Act 2012) to prepare an annual report on the health of the people in the area of the local authority. The local authority must publish the report.
- 1.2 A DPH Annual Report has been produced. It is not a conventional DPH Annual Report which traditionally has lots of data, graphs, charts and narrative. To make the report more accessible to a wide audience it takes the form of a series of 'Infographics'. It presents information on local demographics, health across the life course, health inequalities and how we spend the public health ring-fenced grant received from the Department of Health.
- 1.3 The Director of Public Health Annual Report is about to be published and is presented to the Health and Wellbeing Board for information.
