## **Petition – Objection to the introduction of waiting restrictions, Catherine Street/Leacroft Road**

### **SUPPORTING INFORMATION**

- 1.1 A petition has been received from residents of Catherine Street and Leacroft Road following public advertisement of a proposal to amend waiting restrictions in the Pear Tree area. The petition reads “Objections to the proposal by Derby City Council to introduce no waiting at any time for Catherine Street and Leacroft Road”..
- 1.2 Waiting restrictions were introduced some time ago to prevent parking in residential streets near to The Baseball Ground on Saturday afternoons and Wednesday evenings. No waiting at any time restrictions were also introduced to prevent vehicles from parking at junctions. The waiting restrictions on Wednesday and Saturday are no longer necessary now that Derby County Football Club have relocated and the stadium has been demolished.
- 1.3 The proposal is to remove all of the limited waiting restrictions, on Saturdays and Wednesdays but to leave the double yellow lines (no waiting at any time) in place. This will allow more roadside parking but the junctions will remain protected by the double yellow lines. The proposal is not to introduce any new waiting restrictions. It seems that the petitioners have misunderstood the proposal and are objecting to something which is not actually being proposed.

### **PROPOSED ACTION**

- 2.1 The petitioners be informed of the misunderstanding and the proposal be introduced as advertised.
