# 87/07 Application for a Variation of Premises Licence at The Duke of York, 7 Burton Road, Derby, DE1 1TH

The Sub-Committee has convened to consider an application for the variation of the Premises Licence for The Duke of York, 7 Burton Road, Derby.

The application for the variation was signed and dated 4 April 2008. It was signed by the designated premises supervisor and stated to be on behalf of Punch Taverns plc, who were the premises licence holders.

By virtue of s34 of the Licensing Act 2003, only the premises licence holder or its duly authorised agent may make an application to vary the premises licence.

Enquiries made by the police when they received the application had revealed that the premises licence holder was not aware of it. This resulted in an email being received from the solicitors who act for the premises licence holder dated 30 April 2008 confirming that they were unaware of the application.

The Sub-Committee therefore questioned whether the application had been validly made.

Counsel for the premises licence holder made some enquiries and conceded that the application had not been authorised at the time by the premises licence holder, although the designated premises supervisor had genuinely believed that it was.

The Sub-Committee considered that the application was fatally flawed and so declined to let it proceed further.
