12/12-13 Conditions of Grants Awarded

The Ward Committee agreed the recommendations for the following conditions on the grants awarded:

- Derby East Live at Home that the Group continue to develop their sustainability and look to reduce their reliance on external grant funding for transport as Spondon Board will not support requests for this amount in future
- Leisure Facilities North Parks that publicity is provided and communicated in advance and that wider range of community groups are involved
- Springfield Youth Club funding for Healthy Eating sessions and the games and equipment and up to 24 weeks of caretaker costs before summer holidays 2013. That the club provides more publicity about the club which is shared with and advertised at other Spondon Schools and the Board. That numbers of those attending each session from each school are shared with the Board as part of the monitoring information.
