05/09 Derby and Derbyshire Licensing Protocol

06/09 Mobile Home Site Licence Conditions

The Committee considered a report from the Director of Environmental Services on Mobile Home Site Licence Conditions. Local authorities licence various types of caravan sites under the provisions of the Caravan Sites and Control of Development Act 1960. The site licence is issued as a 'one-off' not on a yearly basis.

Members raised concerns about outstanding health and safety issues. It was noted that there had been previous consultation of the conditions but it was felt any amendments should again be forwarded to the site owner/occupiers.
