Appointment of Monitoring Officer, Electoral Registration Officer and Returning Officer

SUMMARY

- 1.1 The Director of Legal and Democratic Services will retire on 11 January 2013. Three of the statutory roles he fulfils are:
 - Monitoring Officer
 - Electoral Registration Officer
 - Returning Officer

To ensure continuity, each of these roles must be re-assigned.

- 1.2 The Director of Legal and Democratic Services Designate is Janie Berry and her employment with the Council will begin on 2 January 2013
- 1.3 The Role Description to which Ms Berry was appointed included the three roles.
- 1.4 Ms Berry's appointment to the three roles can coincide with the current Director's departure.
- 1.5 Olu Idowu Head of Legal Services –General, will continue as Deputy Monitoring Officer

RECOMMENDATION

- 2.1 To approve the appointment of Janie Berry, Director of Legal and Democratic Services Designate as:
 - Monitoring Officer
 - Electoral Registration Officer
 - Returning Officer

With effect from 11 January 2013

REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION

- 3.1 Under the provisions of the Local Government and Housing Act 1989, Councils have a duty to appoint a Monitoring Officer.
- 3.2 It is a requirement of the Representation of the People Act that the Council appoints an Electoral Registration Officer for the City, to be responsible for the registration of

- electors, absent voters etc. The Electoral Registration Officer is also designated as Acting Returning Officer at Parliamentary and European elections.
- 3.3 Section 35 of the same Act, requires the Council to appoint a Returning Officer to be responsible for the conduct of local government elections.
