# APPEAL AGAINST REFUSAL TO GRANT A HACKNEY CARRIAGE DRIVER'S LICENCE TO ORLANDO COLELLA

#### **RECOMMENDATION**

1. To note the outcome of an appeal against the refusal to grant a Hackney Carriage Driver's Licence to Orland Colella (the Appellant).

#### SUPPORTING INFORMATION

- 2.1 On 19 December 2006 the Appellant made an application to the Taxi Licensing Sub-Committee for a hackney carriage driver's licence. The Appellant attended the meeting and addressed the Sub-Committee
- 2.2 The Sub-Committee resolved to refuse the Appellant's application for a hackney carriage driver's licence on the grounds that the Sub-Committee did not consider him to be a fit and proper person to hold a licence due to his previous convictions, failure to acknowledge that his previous convictions were relevant to the Sub-Committee's consideration as to whether or not he was a fit and proper person to hold a licence, his challenge to the Sub-Committee's members' expertise and knowledge and confrontational behaviour at the meeting.
- 2.3 The Appellant appealed against the Council's decision to the Southern Derbyshire Magistrates' Court on 9 January 2007 and the matter was listed for a first hearing on 23 February 2007.
- 2.4 The Appellant attended the first hearing and the matter was adjourned to 29 March 2007 for trial.
- 2.5 At the trial the District Judge, after hearing all the evidence, concluded that the Appellant was not a fit and proper person to hold a licence and the decision of the Council to refuse to grant the licence was upheld.
- 2.6 The Council's solicitor made an application for costs of £470.00 but no order for costs was made by the District Judge due to the Appellant's dire financial circumstances.
