A report of the Strategic Director for Neighbourhoods sought approval for implementation of an administrative process for dealing with complaints of anti-social behaviour received from the public using the Anti-social Behaviour, Crime and Police Act 2014 – commonly referred to as the Community Trigger.

It was reported that the Act included new measures designed to give victims and communities a say in the way anti-social behaviour was dealt with. The report advised that the Community Trigger gave victims the ability to demand action, starting with a review of their case, where the locally defined threshold was met.

The proposed process outlined how Community Triggers would be dealt with, and what the duties and responsibilities of each party involved would be.

Resolved to approve the process arising from a Community Trigger being initiated through the Anti-social Behaviour, Crime and Police Act 2014, detailed in Appendix 2 of the report.
