

## REQUEST TO CONSIDER CUMULATIVE IMPACT POLICY

### SUMMARY

- 1.1 The report provides information on the process involved in considering an application to introduce a cumulative impact policy.

### RECOMMENDATION

- 2.1 To acknowledge receipt of the application and agree to the consultation proposals set out in the report.

### REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION

- 3.1 The Council must consider the application and decide whether to implement a cumulative impact policy or not.

### SUPPORTING INFORMATION

- 4.1 The Council has received an application from Derbyshire Constabulary to consider the introduction of a cumulative impact policy.
- 4.2 Before making its decision, the Council is required to consult with other responsible authorities and interested parties.
- 4.3 The consultation plan is set out at Appendix 2 and follows a similar process to the plan adopted for when the Council's Licensing Policy is reviewed. It includes a proposal for the formulation of a cross party working group to consider comments received during the consultation period.
- 4.4 The application and any comments received will need to be considered at General Licensing Committee in April 2011, for full approval by Council in May 2011.
