Matters Referred

192/22 Call-in of Key Decision 161/22 - Long Term Waste Contract

The Council Cabinet considered the outcome of a call-in of a key decision 'Long Term Waste Contract'.

The Executive Scrutiny Board upheld the call-in of Council Cabinet decision 161/22 on the following ground:

- Proportionality
- Due consultation and taking professional advice from officers
- Respect for human rights
- A presumption in favour of openness
- Record of options considered and relevant issues not taken into consideration

The Executive Scrutiny Board referred Council Cabinet decision 161/22 back to Council Cabinet for reconsideration at the earliest opportunity.

Council Cabinet considered in turn each of the grounds upheld by the Executive Scrutiny Board and concluded that in each case they had not been breached.
