Report of the Strategic Director of Neighbourhoods

CRIMINAL RECORDS BUREAU (CRB) FEES

SUMMARY

- 1.1 All new applications for either private hire or hackney drivers require an appropriate Criminal Record Bureau check.
- 1.2 Every three years, a new check is required to check the status of each driver.
- 1.3 The current fee for a check was approved by Committee in December 2010 but the Criminal Records Bureau have since amended their fees.
- 1.4 A simple change to the format of the fees schedule will avoid unnecessary Committee time in the future.

RECOMMENDATION

2.1 To approve the amendment to the taxi licensing fees schedule as set out in the report in relation to the fee for a CRB check.

REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION

3.1 To recover the cost of Criminal Records Bureau checks carried out for all applications.

SUPPORTING INFORMATION

- 4.1 On 8 December 2010, General Licensing Committee approved the fees for Taxi Licensing for 2011-2012. Contained within the report was a fees schedule which included a specific reference to the cost of a Criminal Records Bureau check.
- 4.2 In March 2011, the Criminal Records Bureau notified us of their intention to amend their fees which means the fees schedule needs to be amended as well.
- 4.3 As the Criminal Records Bureau check fee is simply re-charged to the applicant, the fees schedule does not need to specifically set out the fee. All that is required in the fees schedule is a reference to the fee being the one currently set by the Criminal Records Bureau.

4.4 This minor amendment to the format of the fees schedule will avoid the need to seek Committee approval every time a change is made by the Criminal Records Bureau.
