

## Fit to Respond to 2022 - Consultation by Derbyshire Fire and Rescue Services

### SUMMARY

- 1.1 Derbyshire Fire and Rescue Services are consulting on proposals for a new emergency response model for the city and county which seeks to alter the location and number of their fire stations, emergency vehicles and staffing. The public consultation on the proposals commenced on 1 October and is due to close on 23 December. The board is asked to consider and give its response to the proposals affecting the city.

### RECOMMENDATION

- 2.1 To provide a considered response to the options put forward by the Fire Rescue Services on the location and number of fire stations, emergency vehicles and staffing and the likely impact of the proposals on Derby.

### REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION

- 3.1 The board has a responsibility for scrutinising crime and disorder issue which include scrutiny of the responsible authorities.
