Funding to the Police Safer Neighbourhood Team towards a Laser Gun-£264.50. This is from the 10K Community Safety, Highways & Youth provision money.

Funding to the Police Safer Neighbourhood Team for Primary Challenge-£145.49. This is from the 10K Community Safety, Highways & Youth provision money. Funding to Alvaston Allotments Association-£2,200.00. This is from the 6K Community Budget money.

The following was agreed for the total spend of the 10K Highways funding:

Extend the rear of the bus markings opposite the James Wyatt Public House - £500.00.

Dropped kerbs x 2 at Griffin Close on Crewton Way - £1,700.00.

A bollard at Coleman Street end of the new cycle path - £300.00.

If it is feasible to erect a bus shelter on either Elvaston Lane near Lindon Drive or near the Yewes Residential Home across the Road on Elvaston Lane. Costs to be provided for either a redundant shelter being reused or a brand new shelter.

If it is feasible to erect some obstacle to stop vehicles driving over the pavement near the kitchen showroom shop on the corner of Beech Avenue. Costs to be provided.

If it is feasible to resurface the jitty between Allestree Close and the canal path. Costs to be provided.

The Board will also consider allocating funds for the SID (Speed Indicating Device) but this will depend on the costing of the items mentioned above.

The Board approved all of the Highways 10k spend but actual spend was £2,500.00. The remaining £7,500.00 will be allocated if feasible on the remaining projects.
