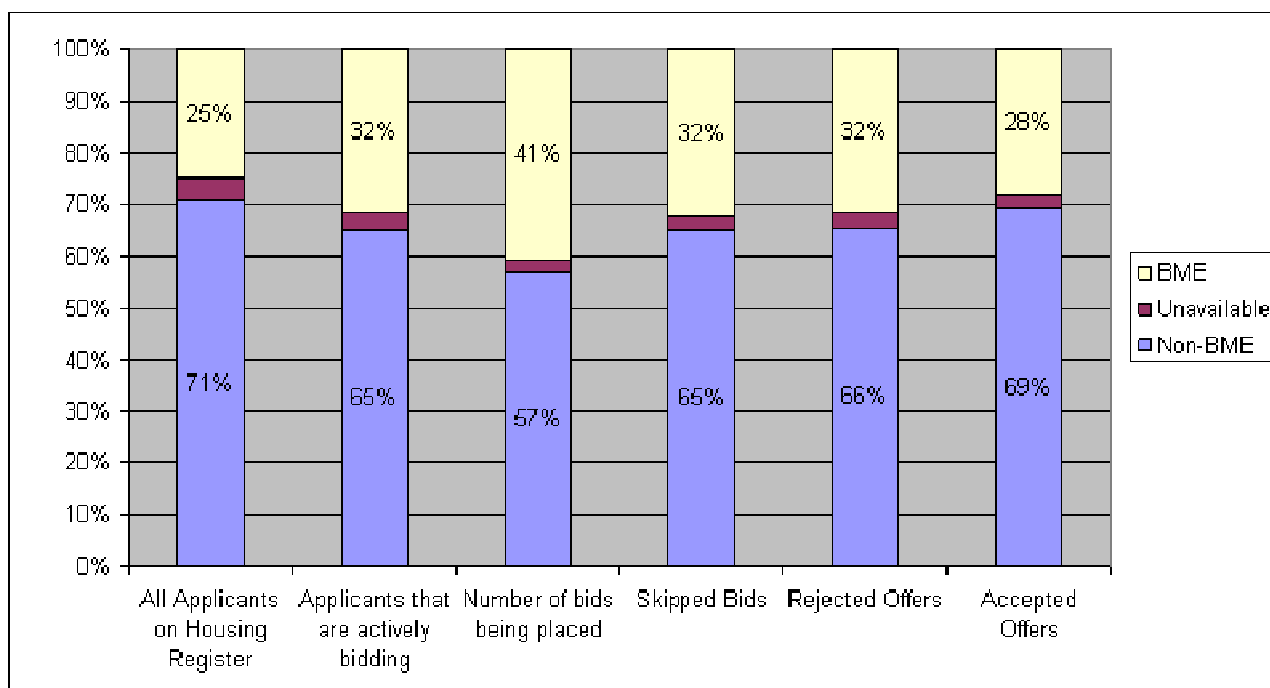


## MINORITY COMMUNITIES DIVERSITY FORUM Update

### Information from Kim Morgan on Housing statistics:



- The first column is the total applicants on the housing register – 25% = BME
- The second and third columns show the applicants on the Housing Register that are actively using Homefinder (ie. Applying for properties) – 32% BME, and how many bids those applicants are making. Each applicant can place up to 6 bids per week, so these figures show that the BME applicants seem to be placing more bids than the non-BME applicants (32% of applicants placing 41% of the bids).
- Skipped bids are where the allocator offered a property to someone further down the shortlist, i.e. they 'skipped' that person's bid. 32% of skipped bids were from BME applicants.
- Rejected offer = the property was offered to the applicant but they turned it down. 32% of these were BME
- Accepted offer = the property was offered to the applicant and they started a tenancy. 28% of these were BME.
