Derby Community Strategy – 2020 Vision

RECOMMENDATION

1. To approve the submission of the final text of the Community Strategy to Council for approval.

SUPPORTING INFORMATION

- 2.1 On 1 April 2003 Cabinet considered the text and Action Plans for Derby's first Community Strategy, and referred them to Scrutiny Management Commission for further comment. Scrutiny Management considered the documents at its meeting of 16 April and suggested various amendments, which have been incorporated wherever practicable. A summary of the Community Strategy has also been produced and circulated to all councillors for comment.
- 2.2 The documents have also been circulated for final comments to the Derby City Partnership DCP Board and subgroup members, as the Community Strategy has to be approved by the Local Strategic Partnership, the DCP. Their comments have also been incorporated wherever practicable.
- 2.3 The final text is now ready to go forward to Council and the DCP Board for final approval. The Community Strategy is within the Council's Budget and Policy Framework. Following final approval, the documents will be printed and the summary distributed widely throughout Derby. The main document and Action Plans will be posted on the Council's and DCP's website and will be available on request. These will be used as working documents within the partnership and progress will be monitored by the DCP Board and sub-groups.
- 2.4 The full final documentation for the Community Strategy is available from the Assistant Director Community Policy or from the Derby City Partnership office.
