

Experimental Traffic Regulation Order Update – The Strand

SUMMARY

- 1.1 Following the introduction of an Experimental Traffic Regulation Order in February 2013 and the modification of the order in March 2013, an update report was presented to Committee on 4 July 2013 as requested by members.
- 1.2 The Chair and Vice Chairs requested updates on the scheme at three and six month intervals.
- 1.3 An update has been sought from colleagues in Traffic Management which is set out in Paragraph 4.1.

- 2.1 To note the report and the update from the Council's Traffic Management Team.

REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION

- 3.1 The Chair and Vice Chairs requested updates at three and six month intervals on the scheme.

SUPPORTING INFORMATION

4.1 Traffic Management have confirmed that:

- The closure of Strand on Friday and Saturday evenings between midnight and 4.00 am was introduced experimentally.
- The experiment can extend up to a maximum of 18 months but any objections must be raised in the first 6 months.
- The period for objections closed at the end of September 2013.
- It is anticipated that a formal decision on whether to make the closure permanent will be made within the next few weeks.
