

## **Recommendation of the Adults, Health and Housing Commission**

### **SUMMARY**

1.1 At its final meeting on 19 March 2012, the Adults, Health and Housing Commission resolved to:

“recommend to the first Adults, Health and Housing Commission convened following the annual meeting, or any relevant successor commission or commissions, that the following items be scrutinised by the commission in the 2012/13 municipal year:

- Transformation of housing-related support;
- Adult Learning Service course fees;
- Impact of change in adult social care fair access criteria from moderate to substantial.”

(minute 99/11 of the Adults, Health and Housing Commission)

1.2 Council established new overview and scrutiny forums at the Annual Meeting on 23 May 2012. The first bullet within the resolution extract at paragraph 1.1 now falls within the remit of the Planning, Housing and Leisure Board.

1.3 The board is requested to take this resolution into account when considering its business for the 2012/13 municipal year.
