151/09 Response to Children and Young People Commission's Report on Review of Gangs

The Council Cabinet considered a report which stated that between April and November 2009, the Children and Young People's Commission undertook a review into gang culture in Derby and the actions taken to combat it, and submitted a report to Council Cabinet on 24 November 2009. The partners in the Community Safety Partnership had been focusing on gang-related activity in the city for some time but the issue became critical in late 2008, following the shooting of a local young man.

Based on learning from other parts of the country, a multi-agency gangs team was established, along with a strategy to address different levels of activity, and those actions had met with some success. In the face of a very challenging budget situation for all public services, the actions of the partners needed to be continually kept under review, re-prioritised and targeted to best effect.
