Street Cleaning Best Value Review – Improvement Plan Progress Report

RECOMMENDATION

 The Council Cabinet is asked to consider the progress made to date on the service improvement plan that was approved following the Best Value Review of Street Cleaning Services.

REASON FOR RECOMMENDATIONS

2. Best Value reviews are required to report to Cabinet, progress on implementing improvement plans on a six monthly basis.

SUPPORTING INFORMATION

- 3.1 A review of street cleaning services was undertaken in 2001. This review covers not only the main street cleaning service which is currently provided through a contract with Onyx (UK) Ltd, but also included the Council's in-house gully cleaning service, as well as ancillary functions like litter bins, weed treatment and graffiti management.
- 3.2 A comprehensive consultation process identified the key areas of concern and the review concentrated on these areas so that the overall service may be improved.
- 3.3 On the conclusion of the review, a report was submitted to Members giving full details of the process, conclusions and recommendations.
- 3.4 A Service Improvement Plan was also produced and it is the progress made to date on the implementation of the improvement plan, which is addressed in this report.
- 3.5 Appendix 1 to this report contains the approved Service Improvement Plan with full details of progress to date.
