13.	<p>Section 106 funding</p> <p>Imke presented the Section 106 paper.</p> <p>All Board members are to email Imke before the 21st September with suggestions for areas of spend using the Section 106 funding provided through the St Helens House change of use proposals. Suggestions provided at the Board included:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Highways to mitigate impact of parking issues caused by the development. • Support green and open spaces, in particular on Darley Park, near Strutts park. • Education for young people, due to change of use from an educational building to office/ conference facilities. <p>A discussion took place about the lack of transparency in the process. Imke explained that current developments should support better transparency from now on.</p>	
14.	<p>Police Report</p> <p>Inspector Roberts advised of the surgeries across the Darley Ward.</p> <p>Inspector Roberts advised that lead and steal theft is currently a major policing issue. This includes bicycles, cast iron street signs and manhole covers.</p> <p>Inspector Roberts advised there is still a high number of auto crimes- in particular theft of laptops, sat. nav. systems and handbags from cars.</p> <p>He added that there have been an increase in house burglaries because of people leaving their doors and windows insecure during the warm weather. Generally burglaries are down on last year.</p> <p>There has been an increase in ASB incidents in comparison to this time last year. The police use Section 27 powers when appropriate.</p>
