Priority 1: St Marks Road - design and implement footway maintenance scheme to resolve sunken pavements and kerb issues from Nottingham Road to Grandstand Road on the Race Course side only. The ward committee agreed to assess the impact of renewing one footway and carrying out some informal

consultation in the next year with residents on options for parking restrictions before considering renewing the footway on the other side.

Priority 2: Sussex Circus – Traffic management investigation and implementation of a traffic regulation order to resolve parking issues and access in particular disabled bays and outside the chip shop.

Reserve: Old Mansfield Road – implementation of casualty reduction scheme, in particular improved road surface depending on outcome of skid test.
